## White Wine

### **Viognier, Domaine de Mont-Auriol ~ France 2008/09**

Honeysuckle and orange peel with a spicy tinge to the palate.

### **Pinot Grigio, Villa Teresa ~ Trentino, Italy 2010**

A dry and lively Pinot Grigio with hints of green apples. Light and refreshing on the palate.

### **Navrina Cove ~Sauvignon Blanc ~ New Zealand 2009**

This wine is firmly citrus with a tropical hint all around the palate.

### **Four Paws Chardonnay Piekenierskloof 2005 ~ South Africa 2005**

A complex, full bodied wine. Intense citrus and buttered Melba toast on the nose. Lime, orange marmalade and smoky flavours fill the palate.

### **Clifford Bay Riesling~ New Zealand 2005**

This wine is very similar to the Alsatian cousins. The nose shows fragrant jasmine, while the palate is unashamedly all lime and spice.

### **Albarino Contrapunto Agro de Bazan ~ Spain 2009/10**

Intensely aromatic nose of citrus fruit with delicate floral undertones and hints of minerals.

### **Chablis, Domiane Alexandre Ellevin ~ Burgundy, France 2009**

The palate is complex and mineral palate with good fruit concentration and acidity.

### **Gavi di Gavi, Villadoria ~ Italy 2009**

This is a dry white with good acidity, golden colour, mouth weight, slightly tingly in the tongue and a long finish.

### **Lugana "Vigneto La Conchiglia ~ Italy 2009**

Lush, full and dry with hints of lime, honey and apple on the palate and a lingering finish.

### **Cape Mentelle, Sauvignon-Semillion ~ M.River Australia 2008**

Pungently rich and vibrant. Crisp and very fresh with a hint of cream coming from the Semillion.

### **Sancerre Domain Villeudiere ~ Loire, France 2008**

Crisp wine typical of Sancerre with a pungent gooseberry nose and palate.

### **St Veran Domaine Cordier ~ Burgundy, France 2008/9**

A superb quality un-oaked Chardonnay with an upfront fresh nose of citrus, and green apples. The palate is rich with a persistent long finish.

## White Wine

### **Pouilly- Fume, Charles Deloire ~ Loire, France 2009/10**

A crisp, bone dry wine with hints of classic gooseberry flavour. It shows complexity in the mouth with a long lingering aftertaste

### **Pinot Gris “Clos de Valerie” Ransom Wines ~ New Zealand 2008**

Light, fresh, crisp and dry, this is a subtle yet versatile wine.

### **Cloudy Bay 'Te-Koko' Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 2007**

The palate is creamy and full yet finishes with an intuitively balanced lemon citrus twist. Incredibly rounded and elegant.

### **Chablis 1er Cru, Vaucoupin ~ Burgundy, France,2009**

Concentrated, full bodied and dry with mineral undertones and hints of lemon, grapefruit and plenty of big fruit.

### **Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Les Chamgains~ France 2005**

Dense, rich and firm, this wine opens out to reveal a fleshy palate with many layers of attractive ripe fruit.

### **Meursault, Prunier ~ Burgundy, France 2008**

Straw-colored with an apple and a lively acidity; crisp and fresh in the mouth, broad on the palate with good mouth feel and surprising length

### **Puligny Montrachet Vieilles Vignes~Burgundy 2006**

An abundance of exotic chardonnay fruit and spice including hints of pineapple with a mineral end and great complexity.

### **Corton-Charlemagne, Labouré-Roi ~ Burgundy, France 2006**

A bouquet of almonds, honey cinnamon and oak. A ripe and robust wine with a noble pedigree that is unmistakable.

## Rosé Wine

### **Cumplido Rose Altovela ~ Spain 2009**

This rosé is totally fruit driven, with soft red berries and spicy characters, but it is also balanced by good acidity.

### **Chateau Les Quatre Tours ~ Cotes de Provence, France 2009**

Made from Cinsault and Grenache, this wine has a lovely colour with subtle berry flavours and a gentle herby edge.

### **Sancerre rose Domain Villaudiere~ Loire, France, 2009**

This wine has subtlety, elegance and succulent red fruits.

## Red Wine

### **Cabernet Sauvignon Domaine de la Citadele ~ France 2005**

An elegant Cabernet with flavours of black fruit and a clean finish.

### **Fleurie, Charles Pierre ~ Beaujolais, France 2009**

This wine has a vivid and intensive red robe with aromas of raspberry and strawberry.

### **Chianti Colli Senesi, Poggio Salvi ~ Tuscany, Italy 2007**

Full-bodied with plum and cherry fruit aplenty. A lingering finish with spicy notes.

### **Ribera del Duero Reserva, Vecordia ~ Spain 2004**

Superb density and texture along with complex flavors. Very classy with some oak evidence and a spicy roast coffee with an edge of dark fruits.

### **Rioja Valdejimena, Crianza ~ Spain 2005/06**

Lovely, persistent blackberry and cherry fruit, with a touch of liquorice and tobacco. Full-bodied, with firm tannins fading into a long, spicy finish.

### **Terrazas Reserva Malbec ~ Argentina 2008**

Intense blend of berries, plums and violets. Soft and refreshing with liquorice notes and savoury tannin.

### **Elcione Merlot - Cabernet Sauvignon Tenuta Vitalonga 2006**

Pronounced ruby red showing a rich spicy bouquet of varietal characteristics; marry together with fruity overtones and traces of vanilla.

### **Chateau de L'Orangerie Grand Cuvee ~ Bordeaux, France 2006**

This wine has been crafted into a structured red with hints of cassis.

### **Four Paws Pinotage Piekenireskloof~ South Africa 2005**

A delicate, feminine nose filled with red roses, carnations and dark chocolate. Mocha, spice and chocolate follow through on the palate.

### **Chateau Lucas saint-Emillion ~ Bordeaux, France 2005**

The wine is medium-bodied and is a perfect blend of the ripe, spicy-juiciness of the Merlot grape supported by the Cabernet Franc

### **Pinot Noir Cotes de Beaune Domaine des Echards 2008/9**

Absolutely bursting with ripe cherries, crushed strawberries and Raspberries, this wine is well structured, has ripe tannins and a spicy finish

### **Cloudy Bay, Pinot Noir ~ New Zealand 2008**

Opulent aromas of dark plums, cardamom spice and earthy liquorice. The palate is highly concentrated with silky tannins.

## Red Wine

### **Cape Mentelle, Cabernet Merlot ~ Australia 2007**

Lots of structure and pleasing raft of cool fruit backed up by plentiful fruit.

### **Gevrey Chambertin, Charles Pierre ~ Burgundy, France 2007**

A firm wine with good deep colour, a bouquet of fruit, spice and liquorice. Well-defined with a long, velvety finish.

### **Chateauneuf du Pape, Grand Veneur ~ Rhone, France, 2007**

The palate reveals the aromatic complexity; spices and black fruit that boast soft tannins. The finish is long with hints of liquorice and pepper.

### **Barolo Riserva Cannubi ~ Piedmont, Italy 2003**

Full-bodied, with plenty of fascinating aromas, including dark berries, plum and dried flowers. Silky tannins with a refined long finish.

### **Brunello di Montalcino Il Carlo Magno ~ Tuscany, Italy 2005**

Intense ruby colour with hints of garnet. A light ethereal nose which builds into a powerful and richly satisfying palate.

### **Nuit St Georges, Les Allots ~ Burgundy, France 2003**

This is a lively, medium bodied wine with black cherry fruit and notes of rich plum yet nonetheless remains superbly fresh with a clean finish.

### **Chateau La Pointe ~ Pomerol, France 2000**

Toasted wood, coffee, cigar box, ripe fruit. The aromas announce a great wine for enjoyment. Opulent, silky, supple and spicy with a long finish.

### **Amarone de la Valpolicella, Corte Aleardi ~ Veneto, Italy 2004/05**

Massively concentrated flavors and aromas of cherries, black fruits and spice. A powerful, full bodied offering with a stunning finish.

### **Chateau Talbot ~ Saint Julien, France 2002**

A very perfumed nose with notes of blackcurrants, blackberries, red flower blossoms, leaving a light and soft impression.

### **Supertuscan Vignare ~ Bolgheri superior DOC, G-Strozzi, Italy 2005**

Full with a great structure and a silky tannins; nuances of coconut and tobacco, with long persistence on the palate.

### **Cheval Andes, Blend ~ Argentina 2005**

Supple yet dense, black currant, plum and raspberry fruit, along with taut vanilla and mineral notes. Tight finish is held in check by the tannins.

### **Chateau Leoville-Poyferre ~ Saint Julien, France 1998**

Exotic nose: ripe and menthol-laced, smoky and herby. On the palate rich ripe fruit and new oak are nicely integrated with the tannin.

## **Red Wine**

### **Chateau Montrose ~ Saint-Estephe, France 1999**

Imperial purple in color. The bouquet is strong and rustic with aromas of currant and black cherry. Medium bodied with a rather silky texture.

### **Chateau Pichon-Longeville Comtes de Lalande~Pauillac 1989**

Exotic nose: ripe and menthol-laced, smoky and herby. This is a huge wine on the palate rich ripe fruit and new oak are nicely integrated.

### **Chateau Margaux 2004**

The color is opaque purple. The wine offers extraordinarily pure notes of blackberries, cassis, pain grille, and flowers, gorgeous sweetness, a seamless personality, and full body, with nothing out of place.

### **Chateau Latour 1er ~ Pauillac, France 1998**

It possesses lots of tannin and depth, along with medium to full body. sweet, jammy fruit is intertwined with dried herbs, coffee, and earth .

### **Chateau Angelus 1er ~ Saint Emillion 2000**

This port-like colored wine reveals scents of licorice, truffles, blackberries, incense. The tannin is phenomenally concentrated, full-bodied, and rich.

### **Chateau Leoville Las Cases ~ Saint Julien, France 1975**

Ruby red with an orange rim. Huge nose of cedar and lead pencil with a bit of fruit still hanging in there. Very smooth, tannins are fully integrated.

### **Chateau Lafite Rothschild 1er cru ~ Pauillac, France 1996**

This wine exhibits a thick-looking, ruby/purple color, and a knock-out nose of lead pencil, minerals, flowers, and black currant scents. Extremely powerful and full-bodied.
